

Request For Proposals (RFP) – Transitional or Permanent Housing Programs

As many of you know, the New Hampshire Hospital Transitional Housing Program funded through the HUD Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) will not be renewed in the 2010 NOFA due to changes in program eligibility. This means that \$236,886.00 became available to fund another transitional or permanent housing program in the BOS for the 2010 NOFA. On March 23rd Maureen Ryan sent out a request for letters of intent, and the BHHS received nine.

Attached is a Request for Proposals (RFP) for those agencies applying for funding. Please remember that to be eligible to apply you must have submitted a letter of intent to the Bureau by April 2nd. At the BOS meeting on April 27th there will be an opportunity to review and discuss the RFP/process. It is important that anyone who is applying for this funding attend the BOS meeting.
